

# Private Dentistry FAQ

**Q) What are the benefits of private dental treatment?**

**A)**

- Allows us to provide you with a more personal style of service.
- Provides greater choice for patients. Treatment on the NHS can be limited and often does not include desirable cosmetic treatment that our patients ask for (white fillings and dental implants etc.).

**Q) How can I find out about the costs of private dentistry?**

**A)** An exact quotation will usually only be possible after an examination, as we will need to know the extent of the treatment necessary. You will be given the cost of an examination up front when making an appointment. Written estimations and treatment plans can be provided upon request, particularly for extensive or expensive courses of treatment.

**Q) How do I know that the private treatment suggested is really necessary?**

**A)** We're ethical dentists, not sales people, our aim is to build relationships with our patients and to help them to achieve the best dental health possible. There are strict regulations set, not only by ourselves, but by third party regulatory organisations to ensure that our patients are being cared for correctly.

**Q) The monthly cost sounds expensive for the private plan membership, why should I pay it?**

**A)**

- It reduces the risk of expensive restorative treatment by encouraging regular attendance.
- Private plan membership actually saves you money over private, pay-as-you-go treatment.
- It allows you to spread the cost of routine dental care through a convenient monthly Direct Debit, so that you don't get hit by large, unexpected bills.
- Most further treatment is subject to a membership discount, saving you more money.



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
